

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

After doing the research and investigating the students' problems in writing journal article experienced by English students at Muhammadiyah University of Bengkulu, the researcher found two conclusions.

- a. There are four problems faced by students in writing journal article. The problems are in writing the introduction, method, result & discussion and conclusion section. In introduction, students usually don't put the components like background, gap, question and purpose. In method, students' journal articles don't have components like research design, reason of method used; sampling plans, method analysis and data-reduction procedures. Then, some journal articles don't have a presentation of result in result and discussion section. Last, in conclusion, students don't include suggestion or recommendation of the research.
- b. According to table 4.1 result of students' problem in writing journal article, the method frequency is 19 of 22 journal articles with 86%. Thus, the most dominant problems faced by students in writing journal article is method section writing.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on conclusion of this research, the researcher recommends that:

a. Lecturer

This research will be useful for the lecturer in order to design and develop the lesson planning relates to improve students' ability to write a good journal article in writing class.

c. Further research

There is still weakness in this current study. Therefore, the next researcher should make the next research related to this topic about factor causing students' problems in writing journal article at English Education Study Program of Muhammadiyah University of Bengkulu by investigating through students' perception.
